

REGULATION
by the Rector of the Krakow University of Economics

No. R.0211.57.2022
of 26 September 2022

regarding

the provision of library training for the students of the Krakow University of Economics enrolled to the first year of first-cycle full-time or part-time studies or uniform Master's studies

Pursuant to Article 23 section 1 of the Acts on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as amended), it is ordered as follows:

§1

1. All students enrolled to the first year of first-cycle full-time or part-time studies or uniform Master's studies are required to complete obligatory library training during the first semester of their studies.
2. Students can choose between the following training formats offered:
 - 1) Participation in library training using distance learning methods and techniques, lasting for 1.5 hours, conducted by Library staff according to the schedule published online in the following websites:
 - a) the website of the KUE Main Library at: <https://bg.uek.krakow.pl/en>
 - b) the Moodle platform at: <https://e-uczelnia.uek.krakow.pl/>
 - c) the USOSWEB site at: <https://usosweb.uek.krakow.pl/>
 - 2) Using the guided on-line format: becoming familiar with training materials from the course made available at the Moodle platform: <https://e-uczelnia.uek.krakow.pl/>
3. The basis for effectively completing the library training is to complete the training sessions in the selected format and passing the test made available at the University's Moodle platform.
4. Library training is a course of informative nature, therefore it is not subject to grading and it does not have any ECTS points assigned.

§2

1. The students referred to in Article 1 section 1 enroll to library training sessions individually, either using the Moodle platform or via the registration form available at the Library website and in the USOS system.
2. The information on the Student's effectively completing the library training is passed on to and registered in the USOS system.

§3

1. The Main Library is responsible for developing the detailed contents of the training session, for the updating of information materials, as well as the verification test.

2. The Center for IT Systems supervises the process of transferring pass confirmations to USOS.
3. The Center for Quality of Education supports the Main Library in terms of operating the Moodle platform, where training materials and tests are published.

§4

The regulation comes into force on the day of its signing.
